Preservation / Maintenance Update

- 2022 Condition & Value Survey identified several areas where Minnehaha had not kept pace with updated ABYC industry standards
 - Last report completed 2004
- Our team of engineers and crew members has diligently worked to address all of these issues

Upgrades Completed:

- ✓ New Marine-Grade Wiring
- ✓ New Fuel Lines
- ✓ New High Water Alarm System
- ✓ New Pressure Relief Valve
- ✓ New Stack Winch
- ✓ Electrical Upgrades (Shore Power, etc.)
- ✓ Rudder Re-Assembly Completed
- ✓ Painting


MNHS Grant Decision:


Consolidate the Blasting & Structural Repairs into a single Preservation "Large" Annual Grant (> \$10k)

Funding available 2024

This would delay Blasting until Spring 2024

- The Board believed it was critical that the Blasting be completed this Spring
- Doing so would inform us of any additional issues and allow those items to be incorporated into the upcoming grant application
- The Board chose to fund the Blasting using the \$20,000 payment it negotiated in exchange for terminating MLM's Easement Agreement at the old Bayview property

















Work Plan Moving Forward...

- After Memorial Day weekend, our crew members will begin removing the bottom plates/screens, sanding the hull, replacing loose plugs, recaulking and applying primer coats
- MLM will submit an application for a Large Grant to cover the fund the replacement of ribs & bottom planks
 - Grant request still being finalized (likely ~\$80k)
 - Pre-Application due July 21st, Final Application due Sept. 15th
- St. Paul Shipwrights will handle the replacement of ribs & planks
 - Work would occur in 2024






Fire Lane Survey, Design George Street Logistics



- ~350' direct to ramp



PORT OF EXCELSIOR

- Port generates\$400k in tax relief toExcelsior taxpayers
 - Council is not inclined to forgo any of this revenue to accommodate Minnehaha
- Port is currently at maximum capacity
 - Charter Boat slips fully leased, BSU's at limit permitted by LMCD



Effects of This Proposal in a Nutshell...

Legal Effects...

Effective October 1st, the four existing partner organizations will dissolve and form a new, consolidated LAKE MINNETONKA HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Membership Effects...

- □ Members in good standing would be offered a Transition
 Membership in the new organization valid for the duration
 of the membership with their current partner organization
 □ Those holding Lifetime/Honorgry memberships would
 - ☐ Those holding Lifetime/Honorary memberships would be offered 12-month Transition memberships
- ☐ Membership dues for the new organization are expected to remain affordable
- ☐ Members will have access to <u>all</u> LMHS programs, events, etc.

Governance Effects...

- □ A new Transition Board would operate and manage the new organization – consisting of two directors from each partner organization to serve an initial three-year term
- ☐ MLM-designated Directors to LMHS:
 - Sharon Provost
 - ☐ Tom McCarthy
- ☐ Effective Year 4, all LMHS directors would be elected by the membership without distinction by partner organization

Minnehaha Impact...

- Minnehaha operations and preservation would be overseen by a Director of Operations who will report to the LMHS Board of Directors
- ☐ The search for a new launch site will continue unabated and uninterrupted
- □ Regular preservation/maintenance on Minnehaha will continue

Who is Eligible to Vote...

- ☐ Must be a Regular Member in Good Standing as of the opening of this meeting
- Eligible voters were handed a Paper Ballot upon signing in
- ☐ Eligible voters must be present to cast their Ballot
- ☐ Proxy Ballots are not allowed

Voting Choices...

- ☐ YEA to <u>Approve</u> the Plan of Consolidation
- ☐ NAY to Reject the Plan of Consolidation

Vote Required to Approve...

- ☐ The Plan of Consolidation is adopted upon receiving the affirmative vote of a majority of the members with voting rights present and voting on the action
- ☐ Consolidation is contingent upon approval of the other partner memberships
